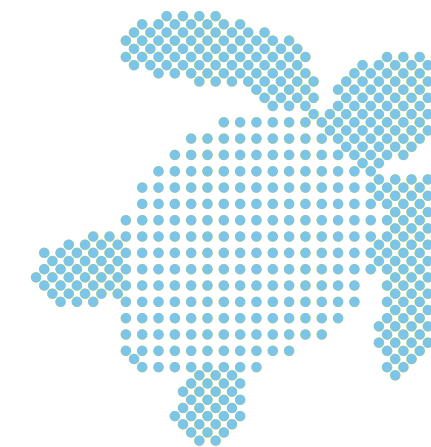

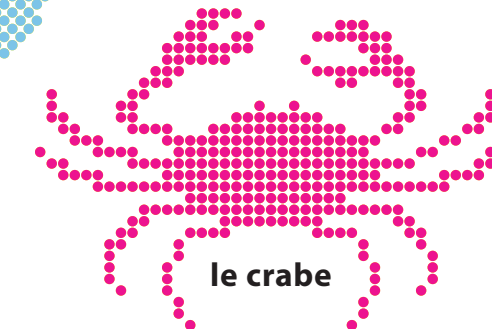

Ages 1–5

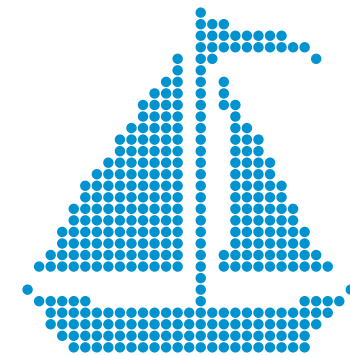
