

Specifications for candidate photographs (2 pieces)

- Photos must be identical and taken within the last 6 months. They must be in color.
- Images must be well-lit, distinct and taken against a white or light-colored background.
- The candidate's face and eyes must be straight toward the camera, with a neutral expression—neither frowning nor smiling, with mouth closed.
- The candidate may wear non-tinted corrective lenses as long as the eyes are clearly visible and not in any part obscured by the frames. Sunglasses are not permitted.
- Prostheses/cosmetic accessories are acceptable if they do not disguise the natural appearance of the candidate.
- If the candidate must wear a head covering, all facial features must be clearly visible.
- Photo dimensions must be 35 mm x 45 mm ($1\frac{3}{8}$ in x $1\frac{3}{4}$ in).
- Photos must show a frontal view of the head with the face in the center of the frame, and must include the upper part of the shoulders.
- The measure of the head from jaw to crown must be between 31mm ($1\frac{1}{4}$ in) and 36 mm ($1\frac{7}{16}$ in).
- The crown is defined as the top of the head or, if covered by hair or a head-covering, the place where the top of the head or skull would be found if it were visible.
